MOBILE PHONE TIP

With the endemic level of mobile phone theft these days, this is worth knowing. (I wonder why Telstra or Optus have not let this one out of the bag...??)

To check your Mobile phone's serial number, key in the following on your phone:

STAR HASH ZERO SIX HASH - as (*#06#)

A 15 digit code will appear on the screen. This number (your phone's IMEI number) is unique to your handset.

Write it down and keep it somewhere safe. Should your phone get stolen, you can phone your service provider and give them this code. They will then be able to block your handset so, even if the thief changes the SIM card, your phone will be totally useless.

You probably won't get your phone back, but at least you know that whoever stole it can't use/sell it either. If everybody did this, there would be no point in stealing mobile phones.
