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Time Running Out For Workplace Relations Fact Sheet Deadline

Friday, 19 October, 2007

Australia's Workplace Ombudsman, Nicholas Wilson, today reminded employers that they must provide all current employees in the federal system with the Workplace Relations Fact Sheet by 20 October 2007.

"All employers are legally required to give employees a standard fact sheet published by the Workplace Authority, to help them better understand the workplace relations system, their entitlements, protections and where to go for information and advice," Mr Wilson said.

"New employees must also receive the fact sheet within seven days of starting work. The Workplace Ombudsman has the power to enforce compliance with this requirement."
